

SUGGESTED PACKING LIST

SAFARI is a Swahili word that means a journey. The following packing list is more than sufficient for your safari, as the staff on a daily basis will do laundry. This list should include the clothes worn to and from Africa. In terms of colors, dark/olive green and brown are best for hunting in Southern Africa. Hunting in Africa is often a game of tracking wary animals in thick cover. Therefore, special attention should be paid to the quietest clothing and footwear possible.

- 3 pairs long or short pants (or a combination of longs and shorts)
- 3-4 shirts (long or short sleeve or a combination)
- 2 pair of light, soft soled hunting shoes (well broken in!)
- 1 pair of old tennis shoes for hunting hippo/crocs or fishing
- 1 hat
- 4-5 pairs of underwear
- 4-5 pairs of quality socks
- 1 jacket
- 1 pair of light weight gloves
- 1 sweater or sweat shirt and sweat pants to wear in the evenings
- 1 small flashlight with extra batteries
- 2 cameras (to have a spare just in case)
- 1 pair of quality binoculars
- 1 kit of personal toiletries (inc. shampoo, sunscreen, medications, etc.)
- 1 extra small toiletries kit for the fly camp (if you end up going to one)

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- AVON SKIN SO SOFT CRÈME INSECT REPELLENT (the only thing to repel tsetse flies)
- Electrical adapter plug to recharge batteries on the generator to power items such as video cameras) It's best to purchase this at the JoBerg Airport. Just tell the salesperson you need the Botswana/Zimbabwe/Namibia etc adapter and they will know what you need
- A car charger is always a great idea for this
- A few large zip lock bags to keep electronics dust free or dry.
- Please leave your tape measure at home.

AFRICAN AIRWAYS BAGGAGE ALLOWANCES

Free checked baggage allowance:

First and Business stays the same 32kg (70lb) maximum dimensions 158 cm (62 inches)

Economy class: 2 pieces with 23kg (50lb) each maximum dimensions 158 cm (62inches).

Children and infants paying at least 50% of the adult fare are entitled to the same allowance as adults.

Infants not entitled to a seat shall be permitted 1 checked piece 10 kg (22lb) max dimensions 115 cm (45in) and one collapsible stroller.

Cabin baggage will be limited to 1 piece not exceeding 115 cm (45inches) and weight increased to 8kg (18lb)

In case of excess weight there will be a flat fee of EUR/USD 25.00 for the first or second bag up to the 32kg(70lb) total.

Normal excess baggage rates will apply for additional pieces.

Star Alliance Gold members, including Voyager Gold, Platinum and Lifetime Platinum will be entitled to an additional 20kg (44lb) of free baggage, or one additional piece. This will allow them to carry 3 pieces instead of 2.

MEDICAL

Consult your physician well in advance of your safari regarding his suggested inoculations and medications. You will need an anti-malaria medication while in Botswana. There are several options available, check with your physician for recommendations. There are no mandatory inoculations for Botswana, but tetanus and hepatitis are wise precautions for any overseas travel.

We would suggest bringing a supply of aspirin, anti-diarrhea, laxative, etc. just in case.

In addition, if lion or leopard is on your trophy list, cough syrup or cough drops are a good idea. These animals are hunted from a blind and absolute silence is required.
